



**PTTEP Australasia TIMOR SEA OPERATIONS

PTTEP Australasia is continuing planning to reboard the Montara well head platform next week.

Specialists from ALERT Well Control and PTTEP staff are carrying out a safety assessment for the reboarding operation and are working with the National Offshore Petroleum Authority (NOPSA) to obtain acceptance for the proposed reboarding operation.

Once safety criteria have been satisfied, ALERT Well Control specialists will reboard the well head platform to assess the fire damage and then determine the best and safest way to plug the H1 well. Reboarding is expected to occur next week.

Today, crew onboard the support vessel *Nor Captain* continue to monitor the well head platform.

The Montara well head platform and H1 well remain stable following Tuesday's successful well kill operation.
