Statement regarding claims of oil impact on Indonesian coast

PTTEP is working with the Federal Government's Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade and the Australian Maritime Safety Authority regarding the ongoing monitoring and clean up of oil following the recent successful well kill operation.

The advice from government is that there is no evidence of oil contamination in fish samples from the vicinity of the oil spill in Australian waters.

Latest information indicates remaining surface oil is located approximately 200kms from the Indonesian coastline.

The company is prepared to look at any new evidence as it arises.
